### Identified Barriers

- **Average of 6 barriers to success; JAG measures 39 barriers. The most frequent barriers include:**

- **69%** of JAG students are eligible for **free/reduced lunch**;
- **45% low academic performance**;
- JAG students have an average GPA of **2.29 on a 4 point scale**;
- **43%** of JAG students **did not live with both parents**;
- **38%** percent of JAG students come from the **bottom quartile in class standing**;
- **49%** of JAG students enter JAG with **12 or more absences**;
- **88% inadequate or no work experience**;
- One third of JAG students' **mothers had not graduated high school**;
- One third of JAG students' **fathers had not graduated high school**.

*\*Extenuating factors such as a larger percentage from bottom quartile in JAG and/or non-adherence to the JAG student selection process have led to lower graduation rates. In most instances, despite graduation rates being below 90%, almost all JAG programs are at or above their own school's graduation rate.*

## GO-DEEP STATUS UPDATE

Go-Deep is designed to demonstrate the effectiveness of the JAG model at a larger scale and over time. Go-Deep will show if JAG can impact societal challenges such as incarceration, welfare/public assistance participation.
